

MOBILE PHONE POLICY

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STUDENT USAGE

For these reasons mobile phones and headphones are to be placed either into the provided phone pocket on the classroom wall (Years 7-12) in each class or put away in personal pockets. When lockers are in use they are to be locked away with student bags (Years 7 & 8). Phones will be turned off or on silent. Should a student refuse to comply or use their phone or headphones during class time it will be confiscated by the teacher and handed into the office or pastoral office for safe keeping, to be picked up at the end of the day. No warnings will be given – this is part of our everyday expectations.

Repeated non-compliance will result in the student being put on a 'phone plan' whereby their phone will be handed into the office or Pastoral Leader each day for one week. If the offence continues parents will be asked to collect the phone from the office resulting in a meeting with Pastoral Leader and /or College Leadership Team member.

MUSIC DEVICES

The use of music devices, Air pods, headphones, ear buds are not to be used in class unless special permission has been granted by the Learning Partnerships team. If students are using them without permission, the same will apply as outlined above.

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
